

Saint Albert 2020 Fall Activities

Guidance

General Spectator Information:

- Saint Albert may limit numbers of fans if needed at home activities based on capacity (IE: 50%, 25%, etc.) or the inability for spectators to social distance properly.
- Fans are encouraged to sit every other row to help with social distancing.
- Face coverings are required for **all** students
 - Ex. Students will be required to wear face covering if they stand/sit in the student section area.
 - Failure to comply with these rules could result in needing to limit fans/students at games
- Face coverings are expected to be worn by all spectators entering the building/facility, exiting the building/facility and when moving about.
- All children in grades K-8 will be required to sit with their parents. Children not accompanied with an adult will not be allowed to attend activities.
- Seating could be modified depending on the event and venue. **Volleyball the first two rows of bleachers will not be available for spectators. Football fans are encouraged to bring blankets to social distance and watch the game from the hill. Younger students should not be playing games on the side of the hills since this space will be used by spectators this year. Please do not bring footballs or other types of balls with you as a fan this year.**
- Frequent reminders will be made via the public address announcer
- Spectators are responsible for their own health screenings. If you are not feeling well, stay home.
- Accept personal responsibility for following public health guidelines.
- All in attendance should be watching the games, no social gathering or play will be allowed at school facilities.
- At completion of the Athletic Event all fans must leave the facility. Parents and fans will not be allowed to wait in the gym or commons or Football field for their athletes. We ask you wait for your child outside the building or in the parking lot.

Admissions:

- Event entrances may be modified depending on the event and venue.
- Admission at Varsity events will \$5 for Adults and \$5 for Students.
- Admission at Lower Level events \$3 for Adults and \$3 for Students
- Activity pass purchases are highly encouraged to reduce cash transactions
 - If cash is used, the exact amount is highly recommended.
- Admission workers will be required to wear a face covering if they are not behind a barrier such as plexiglass.
- Social distancing will be strongly encouraged in line.

Concessions:

- Concessions will not be available.

Media/Event Workers:

- All event staff and workers should remain socially distant, when possible.
- Face coverings are required if event staff can't be socially distant from other staff.
- Media must maintain 6 feet of distance when interviewing coaches and students.
